Lt. Gov. Barb called the meeting to order at 7:05PM.

The meeting was start with The Pledge of Allegiance and Opening Prayer.

DPLG Jordan asked that each club send at least one participant to Key Leader and if you do not have an individual to attend, donate the money to pay for someone on the waiting list to go.

The cost is \$465 + \$150 for transportation. If you cannot donate the whole amount, send what you can to help sponsor a camper. Kamp cleanup is May 20th.

Barb Schor asked for clubs to host the remainder of the year's division meetings. Brighton will host the June meeting and Geneva will host the August meeting.
